KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

DEATH or SERIOUS INJURY can occur:

- Carefully read and follow all instructions before using the baby carrier.
- Your balance may be adversely affected by your movement and that of your child.
- · Be careful when bending forward or leaning.
- This carrier is not suitable for use in sporting activities.
- Continually check the baby carrier while in use to ensure that the baby is secure.
- Only use this baby carrier for children weighing between 3.5 and 14.5 kg.
- Small children can fall through the leg openings. Adjust the leg openings to the smallest possible size for your child.
- This baby carrier is not designed to secure youre child in the car.
 DO NOT use this baby carrier instead of a child safety seat.
- For babies weighing between 3.5 and 5 kg the leg loops must be used. See next page for leg loop instructions.
- Never release the child until the baby carrier is completely attached and secured.
- Ensure child is properly positioned with legs straddling the pouch and both arms extended through the armholes.
- Ensure all connectors and buckles are securely fastened while in use.
- Pull all straps snuggly around your body.
- Ensure sufficient room around child's face to provide a clear source of air.
- DO NOT carry the baby carrier on your back.
- DO NOT over tighten the baby carrier. Over tightening can restrict baby's breathing.
- Babies should be placed inward facing until they have head and neck control.
- Inspect the baby carrier regularly for any wear and tear. Check to
 ensure all buckles, straps, snaps and adjustments are working before
 each use.
- DO NOT lie down with a child in the baby carrier.

Infant Insert

BRITAX RÖMER recommends use of the infant insert for baby's weighing between 3.5-6 kg so that your child does not sit too low in the baby carrier. Sitting too low in the baby carrier may restrict baby's breathing, especially with infants less than 6 kg.


- Connect both zippers by lining up the zipper pulls and sliding the zippers closed.
- Snap the zipper covers down on each side.
- 3 Hook the two loops on the insert over the leg loop buttons on the front of the carrier.


Discontinue use once baby weighs over 6 kg or when baby's ers reach the top of the baby carrier.

Leg Loops


Leg loops MUST be used for children weighing between 3.5-5 kg.


- 1 Choose either position 1 or 2 to acheive the best fit for your child.
- 2 Slide the leg loops on both sides of the baby carrier over the leg loop buttons at the desired position.









3 Tighten the belt snuggly.


Use the excess webbing holder to contain extra webbing.





4 Ensure that the upper connector straps are not twisted and connect one upper connector.







Securing Your Baby - Inward Facing

Children without head or neck control should always be placed inward facing.


- 1 Place the baby into the pouch so that the legs are straddling the bottom of the pouch.
- Ensure that the baby's arms and legs are not caught inside the baby carrier. Always support your baby with one hand when placing baby in or removing baby from carrier pouch.
- Infant insert may be required to acheive a correct fit with small children. See page 3.
 - 2 Ensure that the connector straps are not twisted and attach the second connector.








Securing Your Baby - Inward Facing



- 3 Button the head loops to support the baby's head by securing the loop over the button at the top of the carrier.
- The head loop connectors are only necessary if the baby does not have head or neck control.
- ★ For infants 3.5 5 kg, the leg loops must be used. See page 3.




- - 4 Tighten all of the baby carrier straps until the baby carrier is snug around you.
- Attach the leg loops at this point if needed. See page 3.
- Ensure that the baby's arms are under the upper connector adjuster straps to provide the optimal security for your baby.
- Adjust baby carrier until optimal fit and comfort are acheived. Do not overtighten the baby carrier. Over tightening can restrict baby's breathing which can lead to suffocation.


Securing Your Baby - Outward Facing


Children without head or neck control should always be placed inward facing.


- Place baby into the pouch so that the legs are straddling the bottom of the pouch.
- Ensure that the baby's arms and legs are not caught inside the baby carrier. Always support your baby with one hand when placing baby in or removing baby from carrier pouch.



2 Fold the head support down and attach the second connector strap. Ensure that the straps are not twisted.









- 3 Tighten all of the baby carrier straps until the baby carrier is snug around your body.


Removing your Baby out of the Carrier

Always support baby with one hand when placing baby in or removing from baby from carrier pouch.

- First disengage the upper connectors.
- 2 Loosen first harness strap with your free hand.
- 3 Loosen the other harness strap and lift your baby from the baby carrier pouch.









Bib

- With the long part of the bib lying inside the baby carrier, pull both upper connectors through the slots in the bib.
- 2 Lift the insert cover inside the pouch and snap the bottom of the bib to it to secure.

Product Care

Fabric

- Wipe fabric with a damp cloth to spot clean.
- For heavier cleaning:
 Machine wash separately
 Delicate cycle
 Gentle detergent
 Lay flat to dry
 DO NOT bleach
 DO NOT iron

Plastic Parts

- Periodically check that the upper connectors are working properly and are free of debris.
- Rinse with cold water to remove debris.

Snaps and Zippers
